**All Saints Day**

Each year I talk with the confirmation class about selecting a confirmation name. We talk about the importance of a name and how that name can bring to mind a person's entire life story. I can not hear the name Josephine without thinking of my grandmother and as her memory comes to mind I recall her love and commitment to her faith, in so many ways; from daily Mass, to the rosary, to raising a family. A name is a powerful thing that can bring to mind fond memories but also challenge us to be better than we are. My Grandmother's last gift, a true relic of St. Therese of the Child Jesus, reminds me both of my grandmother's great love and of the "little way" of the young and simple saint.

As we celebrate All Saints and All Souls we should be reminded of those great examples of faithful people who lived and witnessed to their belief in Jesus Christ. We should draw from their example, courage to live a life of faith. The people I know that are the happiest are those who have a great relationship with Christ. While I see happiness away from this type of relationship it is often fleeting. I am always amazed at the stories of the saints that endure great pain and sickness, and yet keep a positive attitude, and seem to be truly happy even in suffering. I also see this in the hospitals, nursing homes and private homes of so many of our faithful right here in our parish.

I do not live it perfectly, and not any of us do, but on this All Saints day let us reflect on our favorite Saint and have them both, through prayer as well as example, inspire us to live holier lives closer in relationship to the one who can bring us happiness, even sorrow and pain, Jesus the Christ. May the Saints intercede for your needs and obtain for you what will truly make you a happy and holy person. In Christ, *Fr. Bill*

Dear Sacred Heart – St. Patrick's Parishioners,

As you are well aware, Fr. Bill has been attending Canon Law studies at Catholic University in Washington, D.C. from the end of May until sometime in August for the past 3 years. During the other months of the year he continues to attend lectures through the internet. This long distance education process also involves writing "papers" in response to the topics being taught.

Keeping all of this in mind, Fr. Bill has an opportunity to travel to Rome on a trip sponsored by the Canon Law Studies in March of 2010. This trip is for 10 days and has been set aside for the students to meet with all of the various Congregations and the Roman Curia (the offices of the Church).

The estimated cost of Fr. Bill's Rome experience is approximately \$3,100.00 and is due by December 15th. Your parish staff is asking for assistance from you to finance this expense. We believe that Fr. Bill should not have to go into debt in order to experience this educational opportunity.
